

Faculty Manual: Committee members' reviews/applications

CPC:

Where a Committee member is scheduled for a review, s/he will be disqualified from discussions and voting on his or her own contract, promotion, or sabbatical. If the Committee member is serving as Committee Chair, the Provost will solicit another member of the Committee to coordinate the functions ordinarily performed by the Chair for that particular review.

For purposes of a quorum, all but one member, excluding those who are on an approved leave of absence, must be present for the discussion and vote. In the event a Committee member is disqualified from the discussion and vote on his or her review, that member will be excluded from the determination of a quorum and participation in the discussion and vote on his or her own review for all purposes. Consequently, in the event of such a disqualification, all other members of the Committee must participate in the discussion and vote.

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UPC:

Where a Committee member is scheduled for a review, s/he will be disqualified from discussions and voting on his or her own promotion, contract (if and to the extent applicable), or sabbatical. If the Committee member is serving as Committee Chair, the Provost will solicit another member of the Committee to coordinate the functions ordinarily performed by the Chair for that particular review.

For purposes of a quorum, at least six (6) members of the UPC, including all three (3) CPC Chairs and half of the at-large members, must be present for the discussion and vote. In the event a Committee member is disqualified from the discussion and vote on his or her review, that member will be excluded from the determination of a quorum and participation in the discussion and vote on his or her own review for all purposes.



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
