



Standing Committees of the University

Shared Governance Committee (SGC) (23)

- Three (3) elected, at-large Senior Faculty from three different colleges or schools outside of a college;
- Chairs of six (6) Standing Committees of the University;
- Two (2) non-voting members from the student body;
- Deans of the colleges and schools outside of a college (11);
- Provost (1);
- Chair of Faculty Advisory Committee serves as Chair of SGC.

Faculty Advisory Council (FAC) (13+)

- At least one (1) elected representative of the Voting Body of the faculty of each college and school outside of a college;
- At least one (1) and up to two (2) at-large Adjunct faculty;
- Chair is selected from among the Senior Faculty Membership of the Council.

Committee on Educational Resources (11+)

- At least one (1) elected representative of the Voting Body of the faculty of each college and school outside of a college;
- Chair may recommend additional members, subject to the approval of the SGC;
- Chair is selected from among the elected Senior Faculty members of the Committee.

Committee on Research (11+)

- At least one (1) elected representative of the Voting Body of the faculty of each college and school outside of a college;
- Chair may recommend additional members, subject to the approval of the SGC;
- Chair is selected from among the elected Senior Faculty members of the Committee.

Committee on Student Affairs (11+)

- At least one (1) representative of the Voting Body of the faculty of each college and school outside of a college, selected by a method determined by the College;
- Additional members may be appointed by the provost after consultation with the SGC;
- Chair will be selected by and from among the faculty members of the Committee.

Committee on Educational Quality (11+)

- Chairs of the college-level assessment committees and one representative from each school outside of a college.
 - A college may elect to appoint a different representative instead of the chair of its college-level assessment committee.
- Additional members may be appointed by the provost after consultation with the SGC.
- Chair will be selected by and from among the faculty members of the Committee.

Committee on Academic Programs and Policies (11+)

- Chairs of the college-level assessment committees and one representative from each school outside of a college, selected by a method determined by the College;
 - A college may elect to appoint a different representative instead of the chair of its college-level curriculum committee.
- The provost may appoint additional members, and may appoint other non-voting, ex-officio members after consultation with the SGC.
- Chair will be selected by and from among the faculty members of the Committee.

Committee on Student Academic Standing (11+)

- At least one (1) elected representative of the Voting Body of the faculty of each college and school outside of a college;
 - Representatives are necessary only if that college or school refers matters to committee.
- Additional members may be appointed by the provost after consultation with the SGC
- Chair will be selected by and from among the faculty members of the Committee.

Committee(s) on Faculty Appointments, Promotions and Tenure (22+)

- Each college or school outside of a college will be represented by two (2) Senior Faculty, one appointed by the Dean and one elected by the faculty.
 - At least one of the representatives from each college or school should be tenured.
- The chair shall be selected by and from among the elected, tenured members of the committee.
- Additional tenured faculty may be appointed by the provost, after consultation with the SGC, to ensure the committee membership meets the tenure and rank requirements sufficient to conduct the business of the committee.
