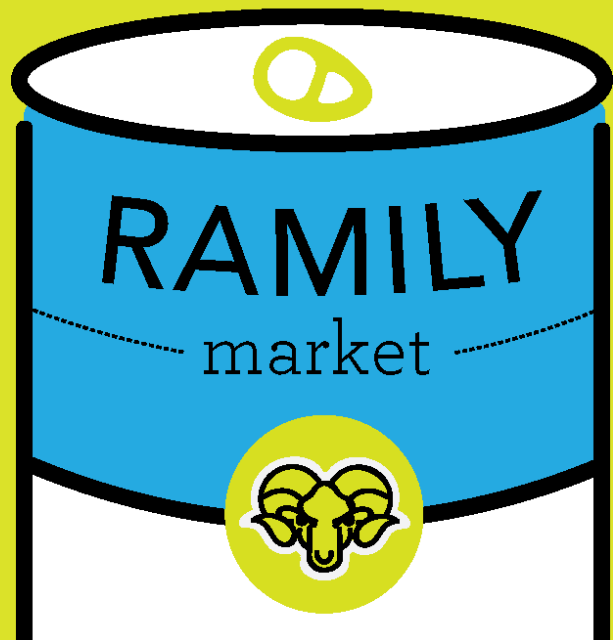

Food insecurity is strongly linked to lower graduation rates.

71% of college students changed their food-buying habits because of lack of money.

30% of students said they had  
been hungry but couldn't  
afford to eat.

22% qualified as regularly  
hungry.

Being enrolled in a meal plan with a campus dining hall does not eliminate the threat of food insecurity.

Among the respondents from four-year colleges, 43 percent of meal plan enrollees still experienced food insecurity.

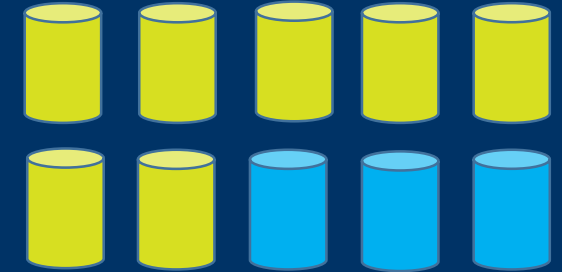
There are almost 650 campus food pantries across the United States.

70% of visitors are residential undergraduates.

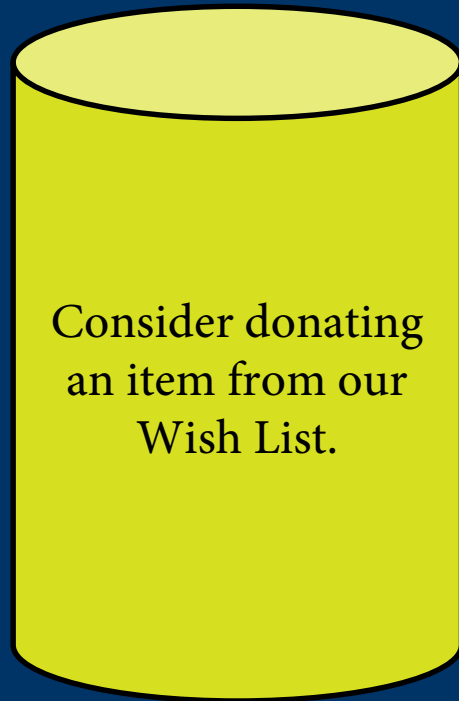

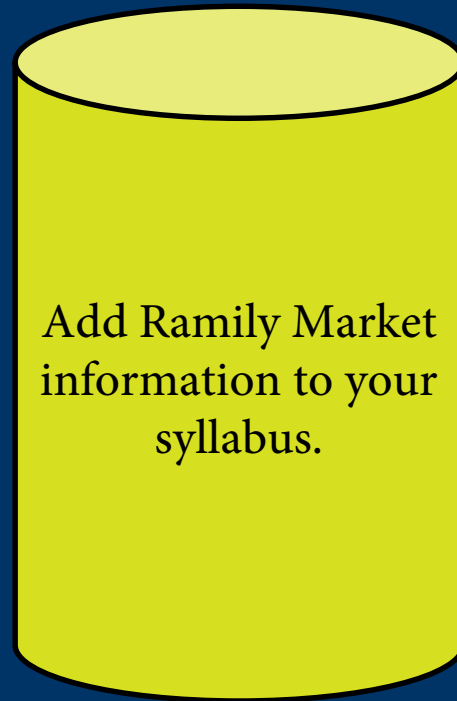
